Procedure to obtain Exemption Certificate for Steam Generator

Steam Generator:

The Equipment that generates steam but has total water holding volumetric capacity less than 25 liters are called "Exempted Boilers".

Procedure to obtain 'Exemption Certificate' in case of such steam generator is as follows;

1. Fee Rs. 600/- to be paid by Treasury Challan and submit it alongwith application.

2. For Coil Type Steam Generators:

Coil should be removed outside casing and kept approx one feet above ground level. Coil shall be fitted with one valve at bottom, Water shall be filled from bottom and when all air escapes from top open end of coil, bottom valve should be closed. Water from coil should then be drained by opening bottom valve and should be collected in buckets.

Measurement of total water contents should be carried out in presence of Officer of Directorate of Steam Boilers, Maharashtra State. If measured volumetric capacity is less than 25 litres such steam generator shall be granted "Exemption Certificate".

3. For Shell Type Boiler

All Compartments shall be removed on ground. All connections such as steam outlet Header, Feed inlet connections, Blow down drain connections shall be dismantled. All compartments and all connections shall be filled with water.

Measurement of total water contents should be carried out in presence of Officer of Directorate of Steam Boilers, Maharashtra State. If measured volumetric capacity is less than 25 litres such steam generator shall be granted "Exemption Certificate".

- 4. Submit following documents;
 - a) Fee Rs. 600/-(Rupees Six Hundred Only.)
 - b) Coil Drawings in triplicate, in case of Shell type boiler details of each compartment and connection shall be shown.
 - c) List of Directors/Owners with residential address & Phone numbers.
 - d) Undertaking in prescribed format.
 - e) Copy of factory plan showing locating boilers.
